Marais des Cygnes District 4-H Shooting Sports Archery Match - State Qualifier Only

August 15th, 2026

Miami County Fairgrounds, 301 Wallace Park Dr, Paola

Registration begins at 8:30am • Flights begin at 9:00am

This match is a qualifier only for the 2026 4-H Kansas Archery State Match. No awards will be given. The match will be held on the grassy area on the southeast end of the fairgrounds. Refer to the 2026 Kansas State 4-H Shooting Sport Fall Match Rulebook for rules and procedures.

All levels of shooters are welcome from 4-H ages from 9-18 that are enrolled in the archery discipline. **This will be a FITA only match.** Juniors (9-13 years old) will shoot 12 arrows at 30 meters and 12 arrows at 20 meters. Senior (14-18 years old) will shoot 12 arrows at 30 meters and 12 arrows at 40 meters. This will be done with 2 ends of 6 arrows at each distance.

Minimum Scores to Quality for the State Match:

Recurve - 120 out of 240 possible points Olympic – 140 out of 240 possible points

Bow Hunter/Compound - 200 out of 240 possible points Open/Compound – 210 out of 240 possible points

We are limited to 64 bows.

Registration cost is \$10 per bow class. Registration form and fees are due August 10th. Please email registration forms to mdc4hshootingsports@gmail.com. Please send only one registration per county/district. Fees are payable to Marais des Cygnes District Shooting Sports.

There will be a concession stand on site.
