The Marais des Cygne District 4-H Shooting Sports will be hosting a State Qualifier trap and skeet shotgun match. All levels of shooters are invited to participate from 4-H age 10-18 that are enrolled in the shotgun discipline. This is a qualifier only. No awards will be giving. Refer to the 2026 Kansas State 4-H Shooting Sport Fall Match Rulebook for rules and procedures.

Fees are \$25 per shooter per discipline. Fees are due onsite at check-in. There is also a \$5 daily State Park pass fee per vehicle (\$3.25 for 65 and older) or a Registered Park Pass. This is not part of the Qualifier entry fee. Registration forms are due by midnight August 3rd. Late registrations only accepted to fill flights. There will be no refunds. Please email registration forms to mdc4hshootingsports@gmail.com. Please send only one registration per county/district. Fees are payable to Marais des Cygnes District Shooting Sports. Check in/Registration will begin at 7:30 am. **Each county needs to verify their shooter's information when checking in.**

Trap: Course of fire will be 2 rounds of 25 clays totaling 50 clays. The break between rounds will be long enough to retrieve a new box of shells. The qualifying score for Junior (ages 10-12), Intermediate (ages 13-15), and Senior (ages 15-18) is 35 out of 50 targets.

Skeet: Course of fire will be 2 rounds of 25 clays totaling 50 clays. The break between rounds will be long enough to retrieve a new box of shells. The qualifying score for Junior (ages 10-12), Intermediate (ages 13-15), and Senior (ages 15-18) is 30 out of 50 targets.

Shooters must provide their own shotgun and ammunition. All shotguns will be approved by the Range Officer. We will follow the 2026 ATA, NSSA, & State 4-H Shooting Sports Rulebook for Kansas.
No resting barrels on toes, foot, or pointed at any part of the body. Eye and Ear protection required for anyone past the Ready Line.

There will be a concession stand on site.
